- **The GNWPCD will present its plans for a new combined sewage treatment facility, as required by NY State Environmental Protection Administration, subject to heavy fines in the event of failure to comply. The NYSDEC has approved the plans.**
- **For the past two years the Town of North Hempstead leadership has been opposing this project in favor of a misguided plan to pump Great Neck's sewage some 20 miles away to the South Shore for partial treatment at an obsolete County treatment plant with large budget deficits.**
- **A bond issue not to exceed \$60 million, at a special low interest rate, is needed, subject to Town approval. Tax impact on Great Neck Residents will be minimal.**
- **Residents of the Village of Great Neck will actually experience a significant decline in sewer charges. Sewer district project will yield an investment return of at least 100%. It will be an ecological marvel.**
